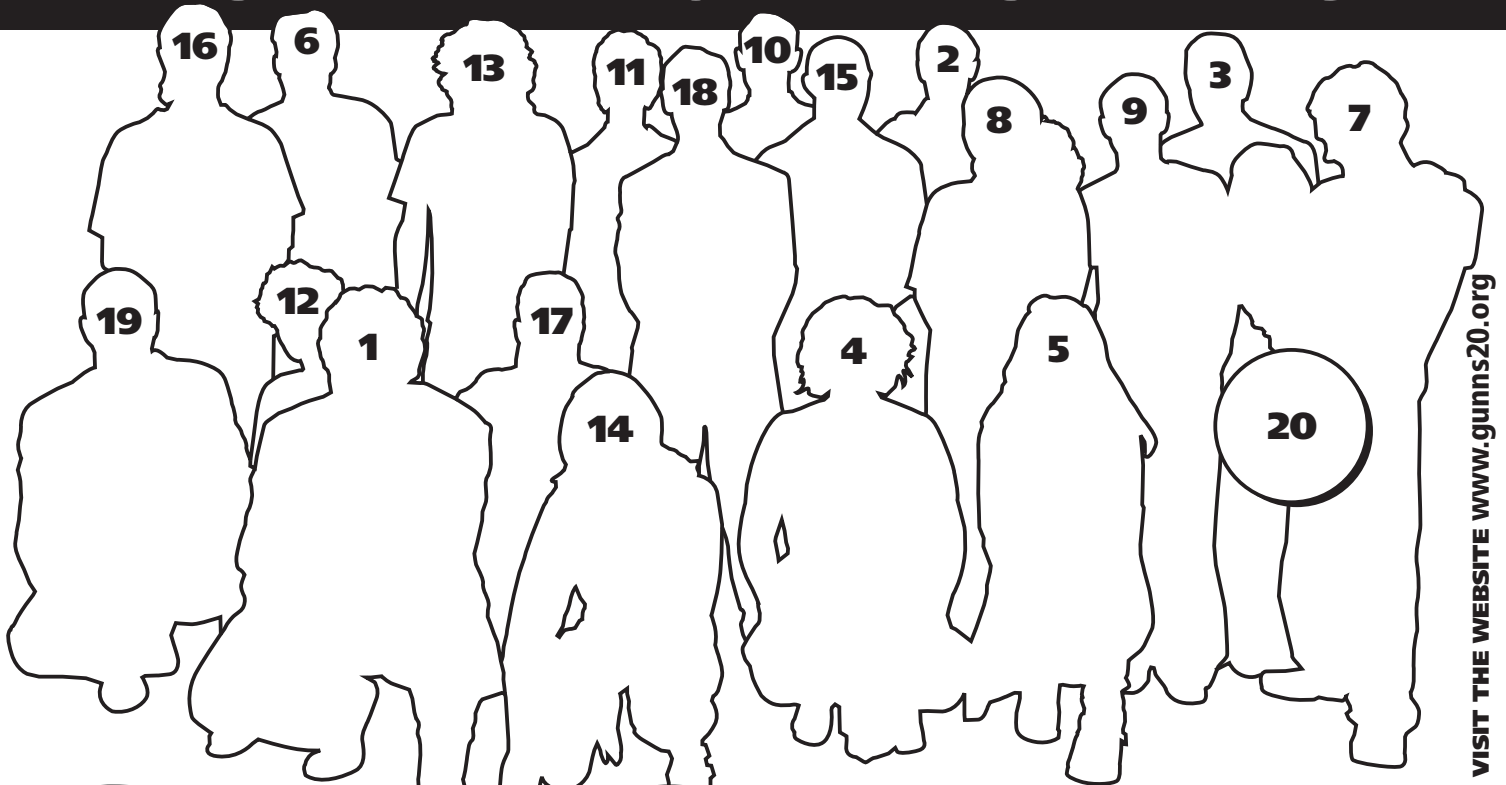

WHAT IS GUNNS20?

Tasmanian forestry giant, Gunns Ltd have commenced legal proceedings in the Supreme Court of Victoria against 17 individuals and 3 organisations (the Gunns20). The claims for damages from each defendant range from \$5000 to \$2,525,000, totalling \$6,360,483 in all. The wide-ranging allegations centre around 9 'Actions', including public awareness campaigns in Japan about the Tasmanian woodchip resource used by Japanese paper companies, ethical shareholder campaigns and protest actions held at Triabunna and Lucaston. Many of the allegations relate to public criticism defendants have made about forestry practices in Tasmania.

Whatever you think about Tasmania's forests, these proceedings have serious implications for the scope for robust public discussion and debate over current affairs and issues in the broader sense. It raises the question to what degree the law should curtail scrutiny, comment and criticism of the activities of corporate Australia.
